 - April 2011 - 19

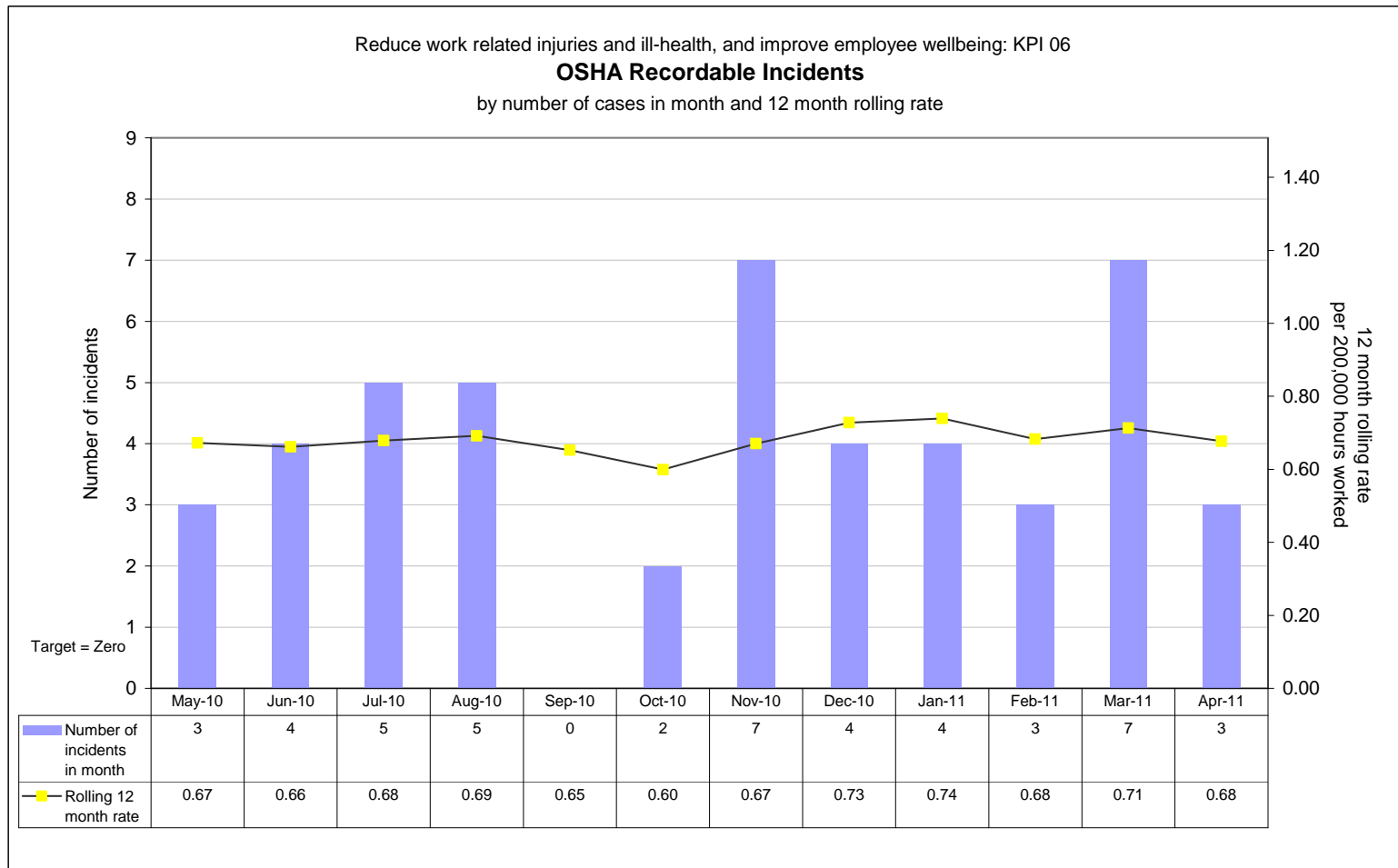


Glossary

- **RIDDOR** – The Reporting of Injuries, Diseases and Dangerous Occurrences Regulations 1995
- **OSHA** – Occupational Health and Safety Administration
- **OSHA Recordable Incidents** – The OSHA Total Recordable Incident Rate is used extensively throughout industry worldwide as a primary measure of occupational health and safety performance. OSHA Recordable Incidents are those that result in one or more of the following: fatality; days away from work; restrictions to work; transfer to another job; medical treatment beyond first aid; loss of consciousness; diagnosis of a significant injury or illness.
- **Process Safety** – Process safety is concerned with reducing the probability of major incidents by the prevention and mitigation of unintentional releases of potentially hazardous materials or energy. It relates to the quantity, quality and variety of controls or protective features that protect people, the environment and property from process hazards.

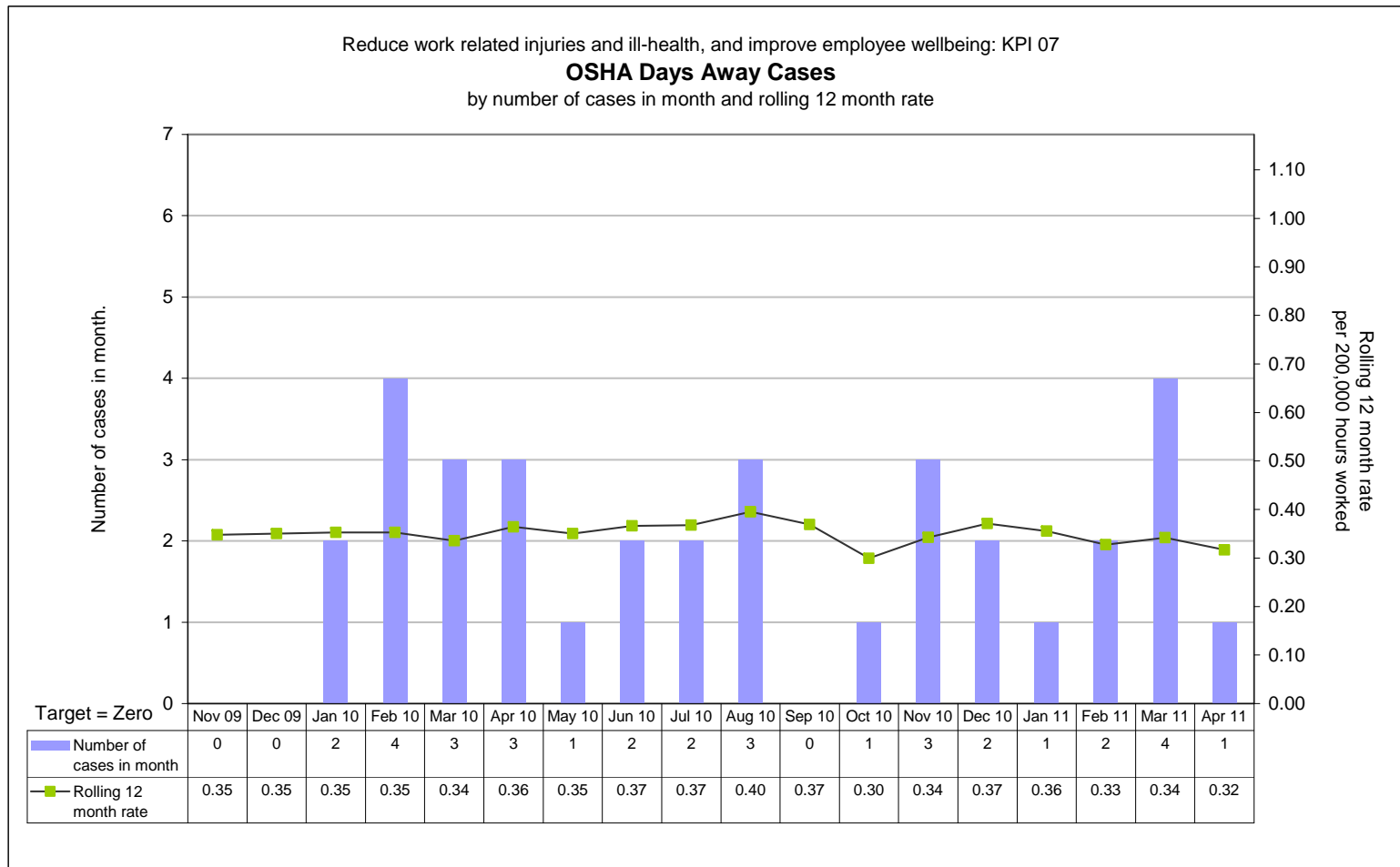


OSHA Recordable Incidents



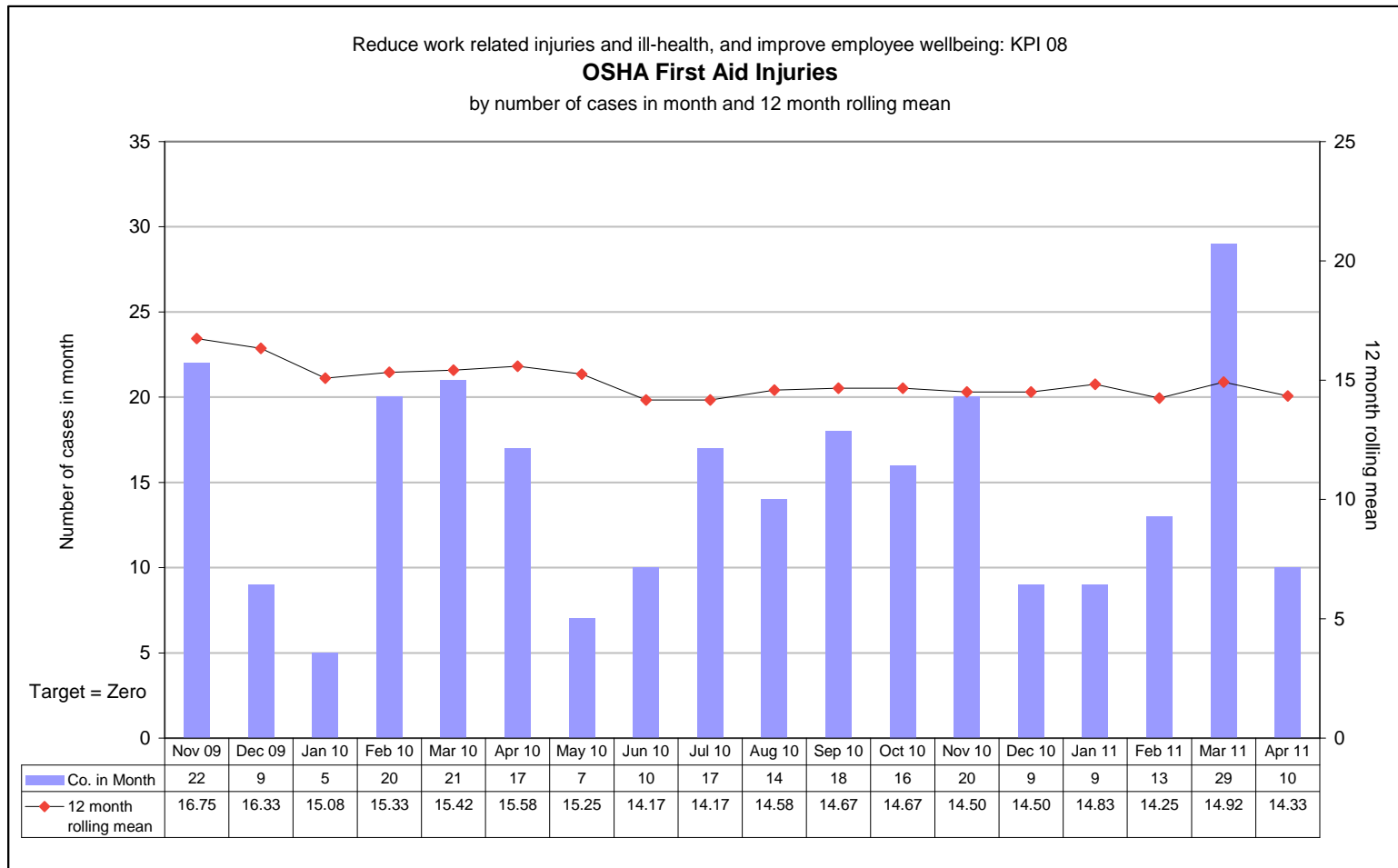


OSHA Days Away Cases



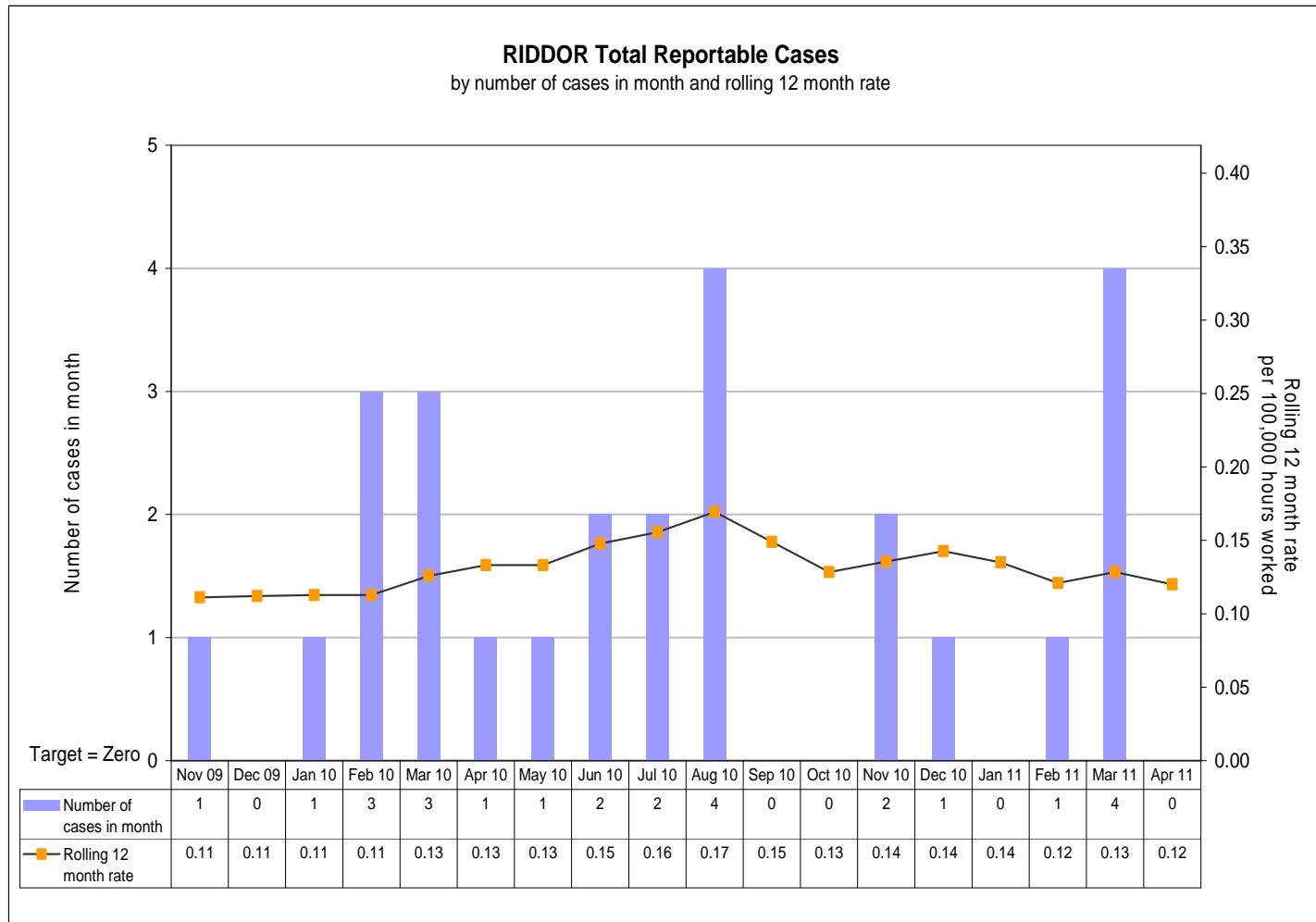


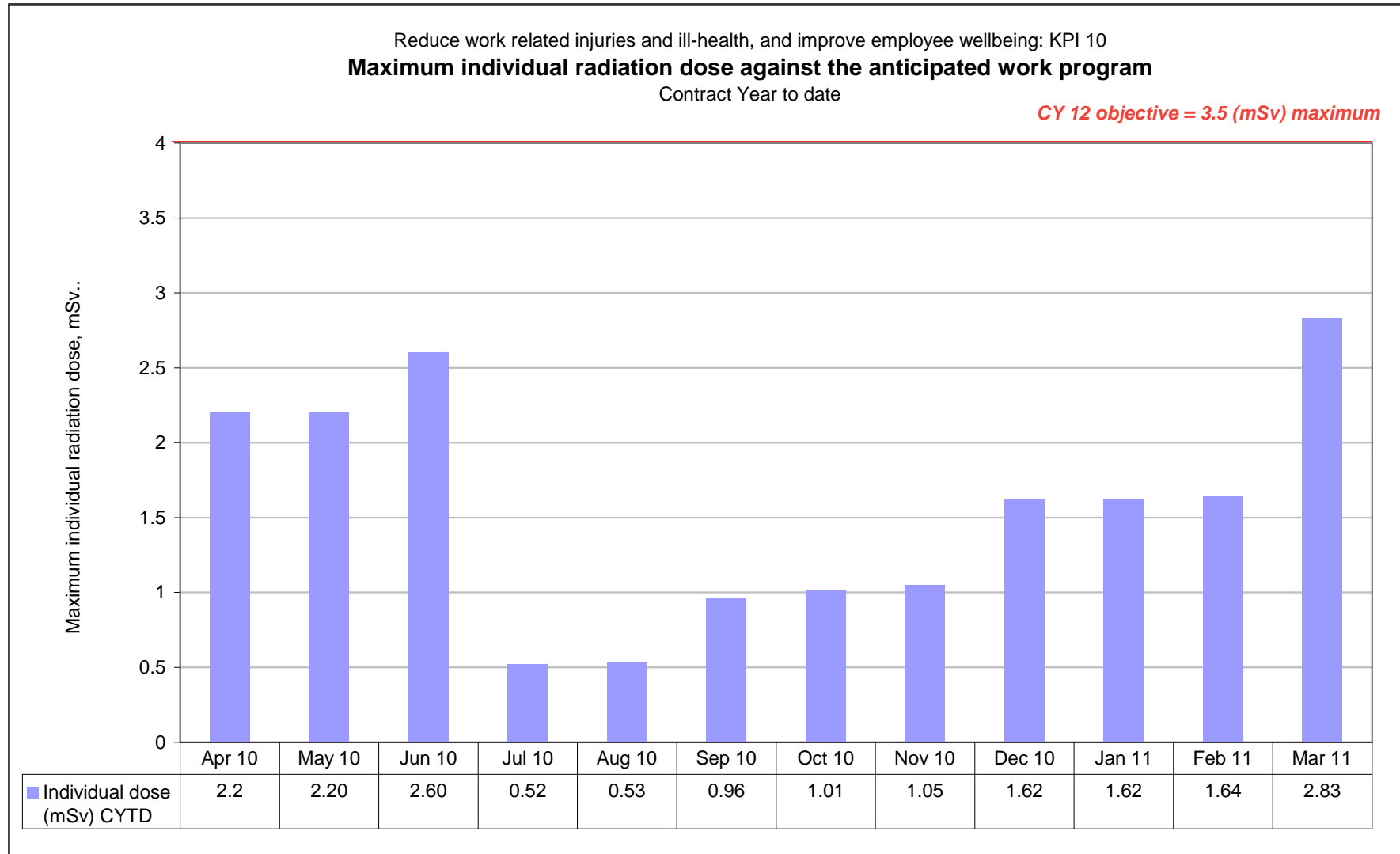
OSHA First Aid Injuries

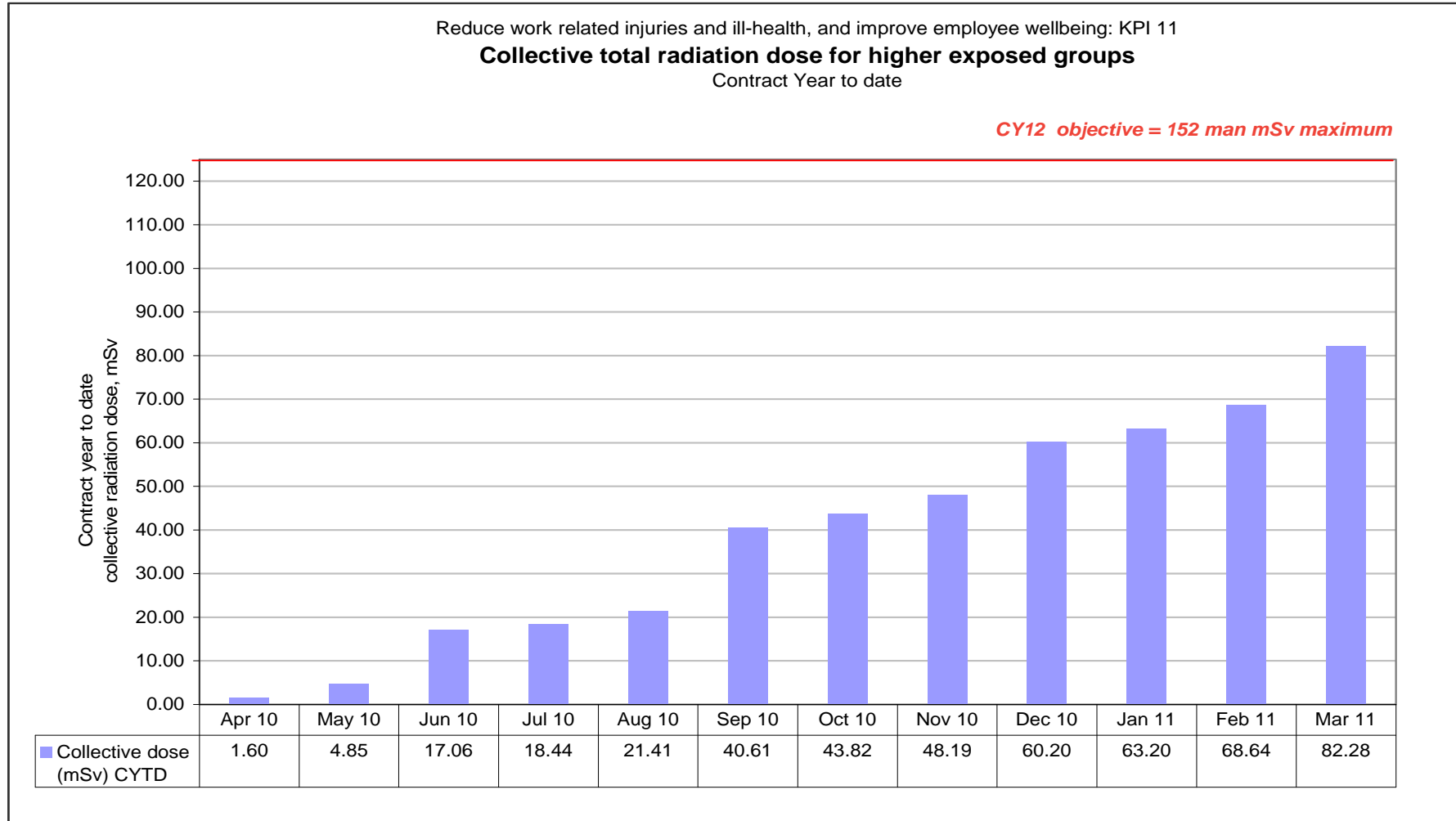




RIDDOR Total Reportable Cases
