



## **NOTICE OF PROPOSED REPLACEMENT BYELAWS**

### **AWE ALDERMASTON**

Notice is hereby given that in exercise of his powers under the Military Lands Act 1892 the Secretary of State for Defence proposes to make replacement byelaws in respect of the Ministry of Defence site known as AWE Aldermaston.

The area of land to which the proposed byelaws apply is shown on the plan attached to the proposed byelaws. A poster of the proposed byelaws and plan may be inspected outside the main gate of AWE Aldermaston on the B3501; outside the Falcon Gate on the B3501; outside the Tadley Gate on the A340; and outside the Aldermaston Gate on the A340. Additional posters are also displayed outside the Blacknest Gates on Hockford Lane and Back Lane, Brimpton Common.

Copies of the proposed byelaws and plan have been sent to the local library at 42 Mulfords Hill, Tadley, RG26 3JE and may also be inspected and/or downloaded from the Ministry of Defence Byelaws Website at <http://www.defence-estates.mod.uk/byelaws/Internet/Intro.html> If an applicant does not have access to the Internet or local library, then copies of the byelaws and plan may be obtained by post, free of charge, from the Byelaws Review Team, Ministry of Defence, PO Box 349, Aldershot, GU11 2WZ. This notice will be displayed in the London Gazette, two local newspapers and at the post-office in the vicinity of the affected site.
