The two articles on Chevaline from the Charterhouse group are on this CD with the papers presented at the Royal Aeronautical Society Symposium on Chevaline.

Also ... in the Word files there are some of my own personal notes from the PRO. I've removed all the material not related to Polaris, Chevaline, Poseidon, WE.177, TASM, and all of it is now in the public domain.

Some PRO files were not scheduled for release until 2009 and 2010, although these were accessed under supervision via the FOI, although it is definitely declassified and in the public domain. Unfortunately, they wouldn't permit photocopying or photography.
