Provide primary sponsor interface with N775C at the programmatic level. Lead task development and definition. Support N775C in representing tasking and accomplishments to N775. Support N775C in developing annual and long-term plan. Duties: Provide primary liaison with submarine commands and SSBN home ports. Lead in the identification and establishment of fleet-directed studies. Participate in Trident Coordinating Conference. Also maintain connectivity with STRATCOM and SSBN Communications programs at APL in support of STRATCOM. Oversee execution of current SSBN Operations Security projects including SSBN Operations Assessment (SOA), In-Port / Near-Port (IPNP), Submarine Tactical Development Project (STDP), Technical / Document Library, and Environmental Support System ensuring technical excellence and sponsor satisfaction. Recommend appointment of project manager(s), delegate authority and responsibility to them, and develop them. Coordinate SSBN Operations security efforts in support of N775 with Nuclear Weapons Security efforts in support of SSP. Participate along with the branch head, group supervisors and the other program managers as part of the branch leadership team, modeling and cultivating a culture of hard work, technical excellence, honest broker roles, an applied customer focus with growth together through team work and continuous improvement. Report status, progress toward program goals, resource contentions and any significant problems or issues routinely.

Requirements

Required: B.S. in Engineering or Science discipline. Demonstrated experience

in operations security. Demonstrated ability to lead project teams and manage project execution. Demonstrated ability to cultivate and support technical sponsors. Must be eligible for DOD clearance requiring background investigation and/or polygraph examination. Desired: Recognized leadership in the SSBN community SSBN experience as a Naval Officer, ideally at the O-6 level, including both operational and shore assignments. Demonstrated ability to manage execution at the program level. Special working conditions: Some travel.
