

The Naval Surface Warfare Center, Dahlgren Division (NSWCDD) is preparing a solicitation for a Seaport-E task order for Software Engineering, Analysis, Research Development, Test and Engineering Support. The Contractor will provide support in lifetime systems leadership and support for Navy strategic and weapons systems control in related core technical capabilities for the Naval Surface Warfare Center, Dahlgren Division. These efforts include concept and requirements development, design, integration and testing of SLBM, Cruise Missile, ASW and Gun Weapon System. The following paragraphs describe each of the areas in detail. These tasks require technical and management support in the areas of mission planning, high performance computer programs, weapons control, systems engineering, hypersonic weapons, reentry body technology and integrated ship strike capability. A draft Statement of Work is attached to this pre-announcement. The work is currently being performed at Dahlgren, Virginia by EG&G Services, 900 Clopper Road, Gaithersburg, MD 20878, under Contract Number N00178-98-D-1012.

A Cost Plus Fixed Fee order is anticipated. The performance period will span five-years, and includes a twelve month base and option quantities aligned with the Government's Fiscal year totaling 60 months, if all options are exercised. Best Value Source Selection (one-step). An Organizational Conflict of Interest Clause as defined by FAR 9.505-3 and FAR 9.505-4 will be included in the resultant RFP and order. The contractor is required to have a facility cleared to SECRET located within an hour travel time from Dahlgren, VA. All technical personnel must have a security clearance of SECRET or higher. The RFP number will be N00024-05-R-3286.

It is anticipated that the Request For Proposal will be available on the Seaport Portal by July 22 and will be open for approximately 21 days. Geographical Zone 2, National Capital. Contract Award is targeted for performance to begin on 1 October 2005.
