**System "Perimeter"** <sup>[1]</sup> ( Index VRA SMF - **15E601**) - automatic control massive nuclear retaliation, created in the USSR at the height of the Cold War . It is intended to guarantee to bring military orders from the senior management (General Staff USSR Armed Forces, the Office of the Strategic Missile Forces) to command centers and individual strategic missile launchers, standing on alert in case of emergency, when the communication lines may be damaged.

There is also the view that this system is a variant of the implementation of the Doomsday Machine , but reliable evidence does not exist.

## The concept of

By its nature, "Perimeter" is an alternative command system for all types of troops, armed with nuclear warheads . It was created as a backup communications system in case the key nodes of the command system, "Kazbek" (see Nuclear briefcase ) and link the SMF will be destroyed by the first blow in accordance with our U.S. concept of limited nuclear war .
