UK Sources Suggest Announcement Will Not Be Made Until After National Day

According to informed sources in the UK the Gibraltar Government announcement over the repairs to the nuclear submarine HMS Tireless will not be made until after National Day on the 10th September.

This has also been suggested by members of the protest groups in Gibraltar who fear that a Government announcement allowing the repairs to take place could cause major political concerns.
