Jack, at the Nuclear Resister, suggested that I contact you for possible help. I served aboard USS AFBD-7, a floating dry dock anchored in Holy Loch in '63 and '63. We serviced the Polaris Nuclear Subs there. I was later discharged, honorably, with a service connected, total and permanent disability vaguely referred to as a nervous condition. For the past 34 years I have suffered much with unexplainable illnesses. I am not mentally affected, but I do have nerve trouble. Lately I have been experiencing an unusually severe calcification problem that is blocking my foramen canals and building up on the interior and posterior portions of nearly all my vertebra. I believe that I was exposed to radiation, not severe enough to have caused cancer, but enough to cause these latent effects of a chronic nature. I need this information for my own peace of mind since I already have been compensated. I just need to know. I would appreciate so very much any information you might be able to provide for me.
