

Decisions -

- ① Unclear whether or not stainless steel cladding what is long-lived LLW will be separated from RPU
 - to do so would require machining
 - otherwise whole RPU to be treated as LLW.
- ② Option is being considered of storing on land at ROS/DEV - which incurs exposure to workers without removing waste for storage
- ③ Activity is not uniform + therefore it is still uncertain how much steel will contribute LLW + CLW + how this will be separated.
