On March 15th 1988, the Junior transport Minister Peter Bottomley revealed plans by British Nuclear Fuels to use Prestwick Airport to fly re-processed plutonium to Japan. The plutonium will be processed at Sellafield, and the flights are not due to start until the 1990s. BNFL have not yet stated how they will transport the fuel between Sellafield and Prestwick.
