

Three charged after submarine protest

THREE activists from the environmental group Greenpeace were arrested yesterday after an incident at the Faslane nuclear submarine base on the Clyde. Using an

inflatable boat, two of the activists boarded the submarine HMS Revenge, where they displayed a banner: Danger: Cracked Subs. Greenpeace claims repair techniques being developed to extend the life of the Polaris

and other workers receiving high dosages of radiation. A spokesman at Faslane confirmed three people had been arrested and charged under the by-laws relating to submarine fleet could result in dockyard

the Faslane base. The action follows a report from Greenpeace, Bring Polaris Home, which claims the Government is struggling to keep ageing Polaris submarines at sea
