Mr. Corbyn: To ask the Secretary of State for Defence how many submarine spent nuclear fuel cores are currently held at (a) HMS Vulcan, (b) Rosyth, (c) Devonport and (d) Sellafield. [87707]

Mr. Spellar [holding answer 22 June 1999]: The number of submarine spent fuel cores currently held is as follows:

- (a) Vulcan Naval Reactor Test Establishment: 2 fuel cores
- (b) Rosyth Dockyard: 1 fuel cores
- (c) Devonport Dockyard: 1¾ fuel cores
- (d) BNFL Sellafield: 46¾ fuel cores.
