I've just got in after my meeting with the Navy/ health authority / local
authority on emergency plans. The Navy emphasised the importance of getting
PITs to children at the meeting. Currently 17 local schools have been given
stocks. I raised the possibility of having 'nuclear' emergency drills as
well as fire drills at schools. They agreed and are raising it with the LEA.

I will write up my notes of tonights meeting and send them in due course.

Thanks for the cuttings. The Navy produced a paper 'mask' their tablet
distributors will wear - looked like something you could buy from a DIY shop!

They confirmed 5000 people will be evacuated from inside Faslane during
Short Sermon - but no public involvement.
