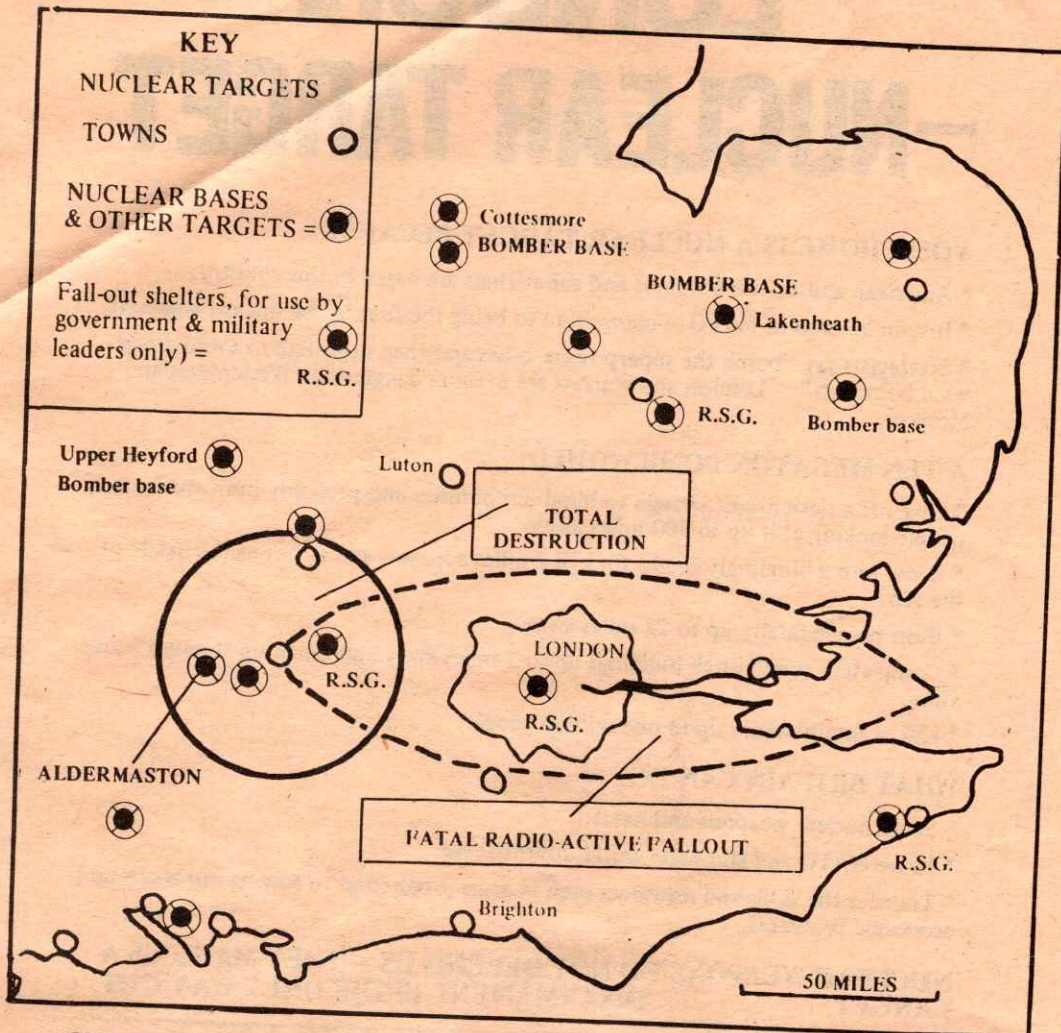


NUCLEAR DANGER ZONE



ONE 20 megaton nuclear warhead would kill almost everyone in the area marked above by the large circle and the dotted lines – that's well over ten million people.

If there is a nuclear war, and only 1% of the nuclear bombs in existence were used against Britain – there would still be enough for 10 bombs to be aimed at each target shown on the map above – including the towns.

That is the danger we have brought upon ourselves, and that is the horror we are threatening people in other countries with – because of British possession of nuclear weapons.

LONDON —NUCLEAR TARGET

YOUR HOME IS A NUCLEAR TARGET BECAUSE:

- * American and British bombers and submarines are based in this country.
- * Britain belongs to NATO — committed to being the first to use nuclear weapons.
- * Strategists say “bomb the superpowers’ allies and then negotiate to avoid world-wide holocaust” — London and Warsaw are in more danger than Washington and Moscow.

A TEN MEGATON BOMB WOULD:

- * Give off a flash bright enough to blind temporarily and probably burn the eyes of people looking at it up to 300 miles away.
- * Grow into a blindingly bright fireball 3 miles across — and as hot as the inside of the sun
- * Burn people fatally up to 22 miles away
- * Completely smash brick buildings up to 7 miles away and block up streets 15 miles away.
- * Kill or fatally injure up to one million people.

WHAT BRITAIN CAN DO:

- * Scrap nuclear weapons and bases.
- * Leave NATO and stimulate world disarmament.
- * Transfer the skills and resources used in arms production to solving our social and economic problems.
