### QUESTION TIME AT THE BUNKERS

On Sat. 16 March 1988, Royal Observer Corps volunteers will be playing nuclear war games at 870 ROC bunkers all over the country. It's INTEX, an international exercise of the UK Warning and Monitoring Organisation. Our local ROC bunkers are at:

Auchenshoogle : Along the A7894 road past the Sheep Dip Hotel,  
100 yards up a cart-track on the right.  
Strathbog : Along the B6024 road on the hill-top behind  
Easter Farce Farm  
Glenfiggles : On the golf course beside the third tee, 200 yards  
from the Club House

Just what are the ROC volunteers doing in their bunkers?  
This is your chance to find out for yourself. Why not pop along to your local ROC bunker between 3am on Saturday 15 March and 7 am the next morning, and ask a few questions? As tax-payers, you're entitled to a few answers.

- \* will their families and pets be going down with them?
- \* do they expect a bomb to fall quite close?
- \* are they planning for a limited or a full scale nuclear war?
- \* is it true they'll be ringing hand sirens to warn us?
- \* How long do they plan to monitor fall-out?
- \* do they pass on information to the military authorities?
- \* what are their sanitary arrangements?
- \* how long do their batteries last?
- \* Are they allowed to smoke down there?
- \* what about the rest of us? Are we to fry in a nuclear firestorm, or freeze in a nuclear Winter?
- \* Do they really expect to survive a nuclear war themselves?

Suggested Draft Press Report for 15/16 March.

Three families (see picture) from Bonnietown CND and Tartanshire Peace Action visited their local Royal Observer Corps bunkers at \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_ on Saturday. The ROC volunteers were carrying out nuclear war exercises for the INTEX International Exercise of the UK Warning and Monitoring Organisation.

The families took with them a tree/flowers/balloons/a copy of the ROC's history "Attack Warning Red" by Derek Wood, and "War Plan UK" by Duncan Campbell. They asked the volunteers if they could go down into the bunker. They asked the volunteers. They gave the volunteers. They organised a competition for the children. They had a picnic. They explained to the volunteers that CND are oppose to nuclear war exercises because the likely outcome of a nuclear war in the UK would be a cold, hungry, thirsty and diseased country, impossible to live in.
