**The Civil Defence (Designation Orders)
(Revocation and Amendment) (Scotland) Order 1983**

Made - - - 20th April 1983

Coming into Operation 28th April 1983

At the Court at Windsor Castle, the 20th day of April 1983

Present,
The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty in Council

Her Majesty, in exercise of the powers conferred upon Her by section 9(2) of the Civil Defence Act 1948(a) is pleased, by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, to order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:—

1. This Order, which extends to Scotland only, may be cited as the the Civil Defence (Designation Orders) (Revocation and Amendment) (Scotland) Order 1983 and shall come into operation on 28th April 1983.

2. The Orders in Council set out in the Schedule hereto are hereby revoked.

3.—(1) In article 1 of the Civil Defence (Designation of the Minister of Food) Order 1950(b), after the words “for all the provisions of the said Act except for”, there shall be inserted the following exception:—

“(i) the provisions of section 2(1) of the said Act as to the making of regulations;”,

and exceptions (i), (ii), (iii) and (iv) to the said article shall stand as exceptions (ii), (iii), (iv) and (v).

(2) In the Schedule to the said Order of 1950 the words “ and soap” shall be omitted.
