AWE Aldermaston –Sponsorship/University Liaison

AWE currently is continuing its development of links with 6 preferred Universities (Oxford, Cambridge, Imperial College, Reading, Cranfield and Southampton.) These are the Universities having the technical and scientific profile associated with AWE's business and where there are existing successful relationships.

The Company currently sponsors 10 undergraduates across a variety of disciplines in UK Universities. At the present time, not all attend the preferred universities but it is likely that all future sponsorships will go to the preferred Universities.

For the future the Company will sponsor up to 6 undergraduates per year, sponsorship will normally be for 3rd and 4th year students across a variety of scientific/technical disciplines.

During the period of sponsorship the students are assigned a mentor within the Company and regular contact is maintained with the individual and the University tutors. A bursary is paid and work placements during vacations are arranged.

Ultimately, the intention is that sponsored students will be recruited into the Company through the Graduate Training & Development programme
